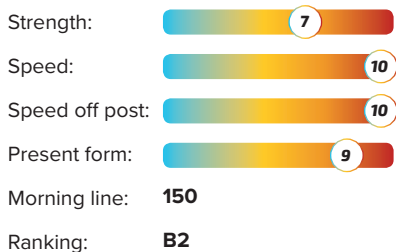


## 1. PASTORE BOB

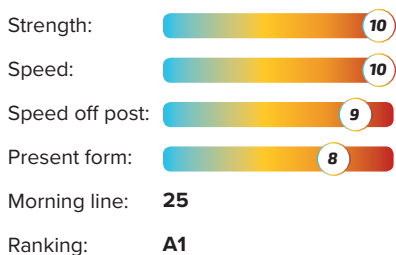


Very quick starter who is ideally drawn. He can choose the tactics here and earn a lot of money.

## 3. READLY EXPRESS

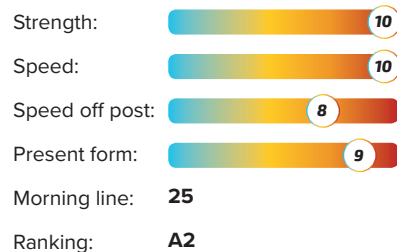


Has been defeated twice in a row now but was not fit in the last run. Good chance to take revenge here.

By winning Prix d'Amerique this winter Readly Express showed that he is the best horse in Europe. This season he has just run a few races and is preparing for a new winter in France. Scored a very nice win in Jämtlands Stora Pris but was defeated on speed by Propulsion in Åby Stora Pris. Was not as his best in the last start due to throat problems. For the first time since the victory in Prix d'Amerique the horse will be driven by Björn Goop again. Readly Express can do it tough and he might also run without shoes here which would be an advantage.

## 2. PROPULSION

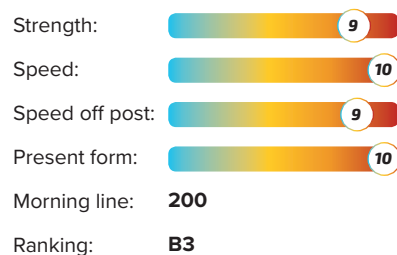


Beat the main rival in a very fast finish in the last Åby Stora Pris. Versatile top star.

Propulsion is one out of two big favorites in the race. Had a splendid 6-year old season but has become even better this season as a 7-year old. Won both Hugo Åbergs Memorial and Åby Stora Pris after great performances and earned 8,5 million SEK. He is versatile and can do it tough. Has drawn a better number than his main rival here and Örjan Kihlström can choose the tactics. Has not competed for more than one month though.

## 4. DREAMMOKO

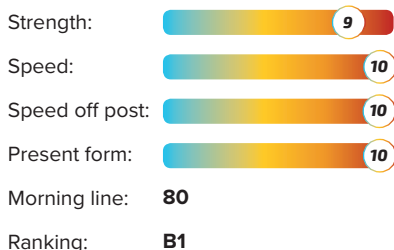


Seems to be at his best when he competes in Sweden. Comes from a victory in the Golden Division and is in good form.

He could profit from the favorites killing each other. Driver Gabriele Gelormini knows the horse well. Outsider.

## 5. CYBER LANE

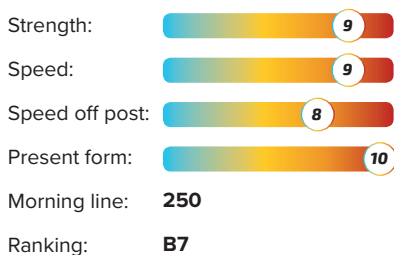


Has been the best horse of his year and won the Derby as a 4-year old. Is back in great shape again.

He prefers to run in front and it will be very interesting to see if Johan Untersteiner could find the lead with this nice number. Finished really fast in the last run.

## 7. MILLIGAN'S SCHOOL

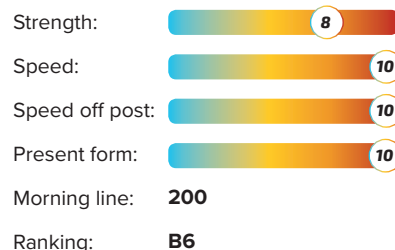


Scored a surprising win against a couple of elite horses in the last Sundsvall Open Trot. Could cause an upset again here.

He has been improved a lot without shoes and could cause a big surprise again.

## 6. NADAL BROLINE

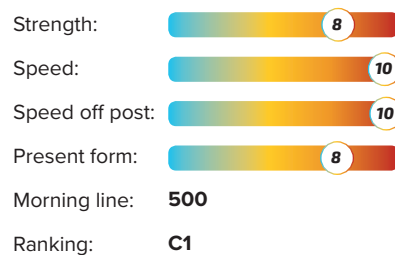


Strong elite horse who is very consistent. Overpace would suit him very well. Outsider.

Nadal Broline has earned five million SEK without being very successful as a young horse. He has been a good Golden Division horse for a while but in this season 2018 he has become even better. Scored a strong third spot in Elitloppet and in Årjängs Stora Sprinterlopp he was really good from outside the leader after an offensive run. He put in another strong effort in the last Sundsvall Open Trot and could be improved by that. Nadal Broline really has the right attitude and Ulf Ohlsson is the most winning driver in Sweden and likes to compete in bigger races.

## 8. MUSCLE HUSTLE

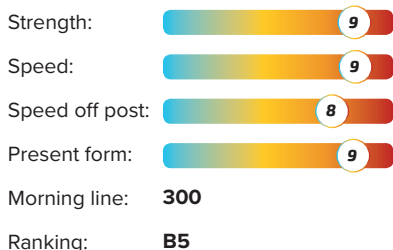


Has found it hard to hit the good form he showed last season. Is poorly drawn today.

## 9. UP AND QUICK

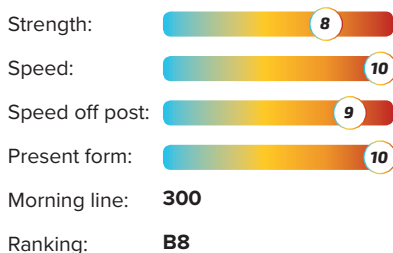


Is still going strong. Has shown great form this summer and can never be discounted.

## 11. SORBET

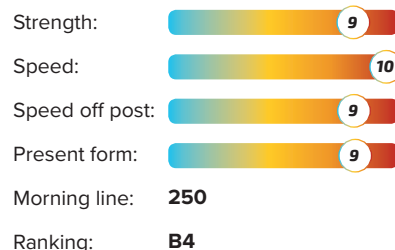


Consistent elite horse who has not had his breakthrough yet. He is getting better and better though. Outsider.

Driver Per Linderöth has his roots in Östersund and will be interesting to watch in his biggest race so far.

## 10. DIAMANTEN

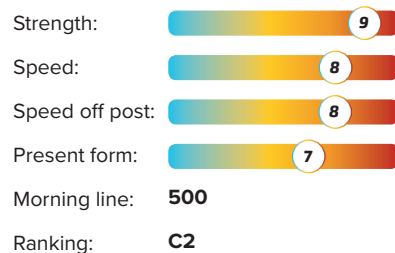


Has 23 wins in 37 attempts and is earning his place in the highest elite. Showed good form in the last run.

Did fail in some bigger races earlier this summer but was not fit then and the mediocre results had some good explanations. Looked nice in the last V75 race and was really brave third up. He seems at his best again and that makes him an outsider here.

## 12. LIONEL N.O.

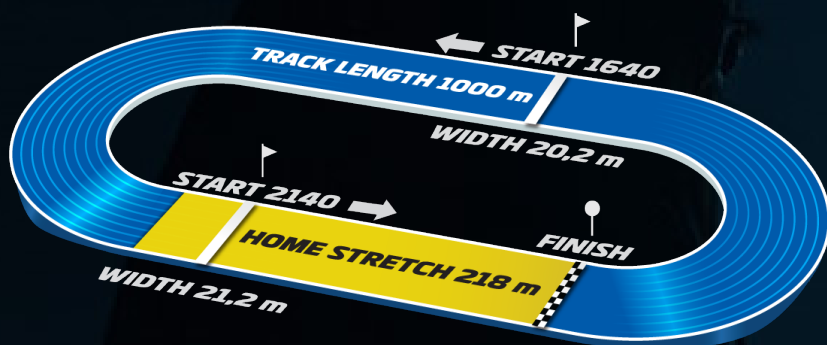


Won the Norwegian Championships two starts back but has not been at his best in bigger races this season. New driver.

This time the Norwegian top horse will be driven by Jorma Kontio, which is very interesting. Strength is his main weapon and fast pace would suit him really well.
